What happened to Live Cattle futures this week? Actually, not too much. June Live Cattle were down .72 cents, August cattle were 2 cents lower, and October was 20 cents lower. Traders pushed prices higher the early part of the week and then reversed. Cash markets were \$1.00 higher with some \$2.00 higher, but packers weren't pushing that hard for showlist cattle. They had enough contract cattle and their own cattle in the Southwest and took what they could use out of the Midwest.

Beef did quite well but even beef had light sales volume. Estimated kill for the week, 640,000 head, shows packers take what they want and aren't trying to pack kill lines.

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Packers in the US are starting to complain about labor shortages. Finding workers in the packing industry was a major problem before COVID 19. Now that other industries are going back to work, workers can find other jobs than less desirable and working conditions within the packing industry.

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<u>As of MAY 1, 2021</u> dressed steer and heifer weights were 863.5 compared to previous week at 860.1, up 3.4 pounds for the week . Grading percent was 83.1 UP .6% compared to previous week at 82.5%.



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

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Pork and hogs decided to go their opposite ways this week. As of the early sales Friday the carcass was up \$2.13 on the 5 day average and from a week ago it was up \$2.61. Loins were up \$5.42 on the 5 day average, but hams were down \$7.68. As usually, buts and ribs led the carcass higher with picnics a little over 3.00 higher. Bellies were about \$3.00.

It was a week speculators decided to ignore stronger pork prices and sell hogs. Slaughter is dropping and with current weights, packers are taking hogs as soon as they are ready. The question? How long can futures drop with a strong pork market?
