APRIL 2024 LIVE CATTLE OPEN INTEREST AS OF 04/09/2024 - 16,124 CONTRACTS

Trade volume was light to moderate Monday and Tuesday. Since Friday's close April Live Cattle are up \$2.45 as it nears closer to cash. Last week cash cattle in the Southwest traded \$184.00 and cash cattle in the Midwest \$187.00 with steers averaging in the U.S. at \$185.89.

So far no cash cattle have been sold as of Tuesday. Packers are going to try to buy cattle cheaper and feedlots are asking for prices back to a week ago with asking prices 189.00 to \$190.00 in the Midwest claiming packers are short bought. Similar to last week look for packers to keep spread between Midwest and Southwest cash cattle prices wide.

Packer margins are deep in the red, packers are going to buy just enough cattle to fill previously contracted beef orders and try to limit daily beef supplies in order to try to maintain beef prices.

If this week is similar to weeks since packers dropped slaughter hours and they push kill the first 3 days of the week and back off Thursday through Saturday, they won't be aggressive when it comes to buying cash cattle.

Packers moved slaughter back above 600,000 last week, but a 609,000 head slaughter is too low when packers have fixed costs eating into margins. With beef prices falling, there will be packers that will be forced to use more drastic ways to cut costs. Plant closures could be the next step. In August 2021 a large had a fire that shut one plant. December 2021 Live Cattle dropped from August 24, 2021 from a close the day at \$137.40 to September 13, 2021 at \$127.15. That was 1 facility and 1 packer.

Memorial Day on May 27, 2024 is the first of the 3 summer holidays that usually increase beef sales. The recent drop in price after Easter for rib and loin primals shows consumers are going to shift to hamburgers, brats, hot dogs and forgo steak on outdoor grills for Memorial Day. Also, look for lower priced pork to replace beef as beef prices drop, pork likely will move lower in conjunction.

April Lean Hogs settled Tuesday at \$90.60 and the CME Lean Hog Index is \$87.05 with the Index two days behind cash prices.

Lean Hogs day have made new contract highs since April 1st. From April 1st to April 9 there has been new contract high closes. July Hogs through October Hogs have made consecutive new contract highs and with new contract high closes.

There has been active Live Cattle/Lean Hog spreading with the majority of trading on June where both hogs and cattle volume trade a similar amount of contracts.

April Hogs are \$17.97 under June Hogs.

Since the March Hogs and Pigs report, June has gained close to \$4.00 on April. The December 2023-February 2024 pig crop was up 2 percent from last year.

Watch the Cattle/Hog spread, what happens when April Hogs go off the board, when trade volume increases and if the difference between the CME Hog Index and the CME Pork Index narrows. Hog futures fell in March and since have made highs after highs.

Packers margins remain good. The difference between the Lean Hog Index and the Pork Index has remained above \$10.00. When packers make money, they want to kill hogs.

Lean Hog trade volume on Tuesday was light to moderate with June by far the most traded month.

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Lean Hogs from June on out aren't packers buying hogs. They may be buying a few but they have been buying hogs and selling pork for months before the recent move to the upside.

FXPORTS

FOR THE WEEK ENDING MARCH 28, 2024 NET EXPORT WERE 28,700 MT. AS USUALLY MEXICO WAS THE LARGEST BUYER TAKING 23,000 MT WITH SOUTH KOREA AT 3000 MT AND CANADA WITH 1200 MT. CHINA BOUGHT 800 MT. AUSTRALIA CANCELLED 3900 MT AND JAPAN CANCECELLED 600 MT.

THE STRENGTH IN PORK EXPORTS IS DEPENDENT ON MEXICO. THE WEEK OF MARCH 21ST, MEXICO BOUGHT 32,000 MT AND IT WAS LIKELY FOR THE EASTER CELEBRATIONS. THIS WEEK THEY TOOK ANOTHER LARGE AMOUNT BECAUSE EASTER LASTS FOR A WEEK PAST EASTER.
