As of April 29, 2024 there have been no deliveries for April 2024 Live Cattle.

Cash cattle in Kansas and the Southwest on Thursday were steady with last weeks at \$182.00 but on Friday packers in Kansas added another \$2.00. Midwest cattle were mostly \$2.00 higher Thursday and by Friday packers added \$1.00 with the average price \$186 and dressed prices \$294.00

Slaughter last week was 7000 less than the previous week. Year to date slaughter is off 504,794 head. Choice boxed beef gained \$1.47 mostly with gains on Chucks as buyers buy needs for Memorial Day about a month away. Memorial Day is the first big summer holiday.

Columbia doesn't buy much beef from the U.S. but to see a country restrict buying beef, the question is how many countries may do the same. According to the latest reports from U.S. Meat Export Federation, Columbia bought January – February 1,243 MT of beef from the U.S. Not buying US Beef sets up they will go to other countries such as Brazil to make up what they won't buy from the U.S.

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Exports are already down in 2024, the U.S. certainly doesn't need more countries to follow the lead from Columbia.

As of April 23, 2024, dressed steer and heifer carcasses averaged 889.8 pounds up 3.9 pounds from previous week and <u>up 32.7 pounds from a year ago</u>. The grading percent as of 04/23/24 was 85.4 % compared to previous week at 84.3%. On April 25, 2023 carcasses weighed 857.1 pounds and graded 83.0%.

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Large speculators and funds are trading mostly from August into November. There are 4 months until August Feeders go off the board. The August into November prices are close to the same and currently are at a large premium to May.

At this time the premiums into August on out are wide compared to current Feeder Index and where April expired. There is close to 4 months until August expiration, and if speculators decide to buy, premiums could increase. Watch the spreads.

As of Friday's pork sales, the 5 day average carcass prices for week ending April 26th was down \$2.35. The 5 day belly average was down \$13.22 and hams were off \$4.02. Loins were down 5 cents. ribs up 15 cents, picnics up \$3.76 and butts up \$2.94.

On the April 24th Cold Storage report frozen pork supplies were up 1 percent from February and it was due to hams particularly boneless hams and ribs. Moving forward, rib sales should increase over the spring and summer, however ham sales usually slow during the time.

Summer Lean Hog futures have volatile daily moves with speculators controlling the trade now that there is no spot month. For example, on Friday, April 19th the low on June Hogs was \$102.25. By Tuesday, April Lean Hogs moved up to \$108.55 and Friday April 26th dropped to \$102.22 and closed at \$102.47. Traders are bear spreading. The June/July Lean Hog spread on April 19th opened at minus \$1.40 with June under July and on April 26th the spread widened to minus \$3.47.

The CME Pork Index is in a steady decline and so is the 5 day pork carcass average.

The CME Pork Index continues to narrow to the CME Lean Hog Index for the 7th day. As this happens packer profit margins are less. When packers lose, they will fight the market especially packers that kill both hogs and cattle. Going forward watch weights. If packers slow chain speeds, weights will increase.

As of the April 18, 2024 export report, pork exports were down 25% below the 4 week average.

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Mexican Peso is moving lower. If the Peso continues to drop, it is likely exports will drop.
