Cash cattle in the Midwest on light sales were \$1.00 higher from \$186.00 to \$187.00 and dressed prices \$295.00. Cash cattle in the Southwest were \$1.00 to \$2.00 higher mostly \$184.00 on light sales. As of Friday total head sold negotiated in Texas. Oklahoma and New Mexico were just 2,557 head.

Compared to a week ago slaughter was up 7000 head.

June and August Live Cattle are bull spread. From October into 2025 Live Cattle are bear spread.

Killing fewer cattle isn't helping the beef market. For the week on Friday morning Choice was down \$2.94. Select beef was down \$1.07. Consumers are buying cheaper grades and cheaper cuts and more pork and poultry.

EXPORTS WEEK

FOR WEEK ENDING APRIL 25, 2024 NET EXPORTS WERE UP 22,500 MT UP 38% ON THE 4 WEEK AVERAGE. SOUTH KOREA AS THE LARGEST BUYER TAKING 9600 MT COMPARED TO A WEEK AGO AT 1,900 MT, JAPAN BOUGHT 5,200 MT COMPARED TO LAST WEEK AT 2,500 MT AND TAIWAN WITH 2,500 MT. CHINA BOUGHT 1,600 MT WHERE LAST WEEK THEY TOOK 4,600 MT.

IT WILL BE INTERESTING TO SEE NEXT WEEK IF EXPORTS REMAIN AS GOOD.

As of April 30 2024, dressed steer and heifer carcasses averaged 884.6 pounds down 5.2 pounds from previous week and <u>up 24.4 pounds from a year ago</u>. The grading percent as of 04/30/24 was 83.9% compared to previous week at 85.4%. On May 2, 2023 carcasses weighed 860.8 pounds and graded 80.9%.

Compared to a week ago the pork carcass price on the 5 day average had little change. As of Friday sales, the 5 day average was \$98.35 compared to a week ago when it was \$98.20. With all the up and downs of belly prices over the week, bellies were down just 34 cents. Loins gained \$1.63 and hams were down 79 cents.

Stronger exports weren't much help for futures trading. But with June and summer hogs premium to cash, it is hard to get them energized to moving higher. Cash hogs have been slowly slipping down and aren't benefiting futures.
