TRADE VOLUME WAS LIGHT MONDAY. SPECULATIVE TRADERS ARE FAR MORE ACTIVE IN AUGUST NOW. JUNE VOLUME WAS 14,798 AND AUGUST GLOBEX VOLUME WAS 22,776. WITH JUNE 10<sup>TH</sup> FIRST NOTICE DAY, THERE IS A LOT OF TIME FOR JUNE LIVE CATTLE TO NEAR COVERGENCE WITH WHATEVER CASH IS AT THE TIME. WITH MEMORIAL DAY A WEEK AWAY, AND THE CATTLE ON FEED REPORT ON FRIDAY TRADE VOLUME IS LIKELY TO BE LIGHT THIS WEEK.

AS FAR AS CASH TRADING LOOK FOR A SMALL SLAUGHTER THIS WEEK AND THE FOLLOWING WEEK. PACKERS BOUGHT WHAT WAS NEEDED LAST WEEK AND THIS WEEK'S KILL WILL FILL CONTRACT BEEF ORDERS AND WHATEVER IS NEEDED FOR THE LATE HAND TO MOUTH BUYERS.

JUNE AND AUGUST ARE BULL SPREAD AND AT A DEEP DISCOUNT TO LAST WEEK'S CASH MARKET. THE BIG QUESTION IS DEMAND FOR BEEF TO REMAIN STRONG DURING THE HOT DAYS OF SUMMER. IS CASH GOING TO DROP TO MEET FUTURES FASTER THAN FUTURES MOVING UP TO MEET CASH?

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CHOICE BOXED BEEF WAS UP 80 CENTS MONDAY MORNING AND BYH THE AFTERNOON SALES WAS DOWN 75 CENTS. SELECT BEEF STARTED OUT UP \$3.95 AND END THE DAY 1.95 HIGHER. LAST WEEK CHOICE GAINED \$18.88 AND SELECT GAINED \$13.23. THE COMING WEEK WILL INDICATE WHETHER THE BOXED BEEF RALLY LAST WEEK WAS DUE TO DEMAND FOR MEMORIAL DAY OR DEMAND DUE TO THE LIGHT SLAUGHTER. THIS WEEK IT LOOKS LIKE LAST WEEK WAS UP BECAUSE OF MEMORIAL DAY. RETAIL BUYING SHOULD BE GOOD FOR MEMORIAL DAY. WITH EXPECTED TRAVEL UP THE MOST IN 20 YEARS, PEOPLE ARE SPENDING MONEY.

THE USDA EXPECTS BEEF IMPORTS TO INCREASE BY 11 PERCENT IN 2024. THE FIRST QUARTER SHOWED AN INCREASE OF 12.1 PERCENT. U.S. BEEF BUYERS ARE GOING TO USE IMPORTED BEEF TO MAKE UP FOR THE LIGHT CATTLE NUMBERS.

DEMAND FOR REPLACEMENT FEMALES HAS BEEN GOOD THIS WHOLE SPRING AND CONTINUES TO BE. CATTLE FEEDERS PAID LITTLE ATTENTION TO THE FUTURES CONTRACTS AS THEY KNOW FULL WELL HOW TIGHT SUPPLIES OF FED CATTLE IN THE NORTHERN PLAINS REALLY ARE. FEEDER OFFERINGS HAVE BEEN LIGHT TO MODERATE AND WHEN A GOOD-SIZED SALE IS HELD THE MARKET IS INCREDIBLY ACTIVE AS THE GRASS HOW NOW TAKEN OFF GROWING AS SOME HEAT HAS FINALLY SHOWN UP IN THE NORTHERN PLAINS.

RIO GRANDE DO SUL ACCOUNTS FOR 24.24% OF OVERALL BRAZILIAN PORK EXPORTS AND FOR 16.23% OF BRAZIL'S CHICKEN EXPORTS

13,000 HOGS ARE A SMALL PART OF THE NUMBER OF HOGS PRODUCED IN THE AREA, BUT THE SEVERE FLOODING IS DISRUPTING MOVEMENT AND DISRUPTING PACKER OPERATIONS.

YEAR TO DATE HOG SLAUGHTER IS UP 5% COMPARED TO A YEAR AGO, BUT SLAUGHTER IS STARTING TO MOVE FEWER HOGS WHICH SHOWS YEAR TO DATE SLAUGHTER 18,209 LESS THAN THE PREVIOUS WEEK.

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LAST WEEK LEAN HOGS TRADED LOWER AS JUNE AND AUGUST WERE LOSING THEIR PREMIUM PRICES TO CASH HOGS. AT THE SAME TIME SPREAD TRADERS WERE SELLING LEAN HOGS AND BUYING LIVE CATTLE.

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EXPORTS AT A MARKETING YEAR LOW ARE DISAPPOINTING. PORK EXPORTS HAVE BEEN A SHINING LIGHT FOR PORK IN 2024. HOWEVER, PORK EXPORTS ARE NOW SLOWING COMPARED TO JANUARY THROUGH MARCH AND IT IS BEGINNING TO LOOK SIMILAR TO WHAT HAPPENED A YEAR AGO. IN JANUARY 2023 THROUGH MARCH 2023 PORK INCLUDING VARIETY MEATS WAS UP 13%. BY YEAR END THEY WERE UP 8%.

IF MEXICO CONTINUES TO SLOW THEIR IMPORTS OF U.S. PORK, BEING UP 6% FOR THE FIRST QUARTER OF 2024, IT WILL HURT THE MARKET.

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THE MEXICAN PESO HAS RECOVERED FROM THE STEEP QUICK DECLINE IN APRIL. THE JAPANESE YEN CONTINUES TRENDING LOWER. THE US DOLLAR IS SLOWLY DROPPING.

FOR WEEK ENDING MAY 9, 2024 NET EXPORTS WERE 21,100 MT, A MARKETING YEAR LOW. JAPAN WAS THE LARGEST BUYER WITH 4,900 MT. MEXICO BOUGHT 4,500 MT AND SOUTH KOREA 3,200 MT. CHINA TOOK NOTHING. LAST WEEK MEXICO BOUGHT 2,600 MT. MEXICO SEEMS TO BE BACKING AWAY FROM U.S. PORK.
