PACKERS BOUGHT CASH CATTLE ON THURSDAY MOSTLY \$1.00 LOWER. MIDWEST CATTLE WERE \$190.00 AND POSTED DRESSED PRICES AT \$297.00 UP TO \$309. AVERAGING \$301.76. CASH CATTLE IN THE SOUTHWEST WERE \$186.00.

A YEAR AGO THE AVERAGE STEER PRICE WAS \$177.94 COMPARED TO CURRENT PRICES AT \$189.44 AND THE CME BEEF INDEX AT \$298.74 COMPARED TO THE CURRENT PRICE AT \$310.30

EFFECTIVE FRIDAY, MAY 31, 2024 FOR TRADE DATE MONDAY, JUNE 3, 2024, CHICAGO MERCANTILE EXCHANGE INC. ("CME") WILL RESET PRICE LIMITS FOR LIVE CATTLE AND FEEDER CATTLE FUTURES CONTRACTS (THE "CONTRACTS). THIS IS THE ANNUAL RESET THAT IS STIPULATED BY THE VARIABLE PRICE LIMITS MECHANISM PURSUANT TO CME RULEBOOK CHAPTERS 101 AND 102, AS LINKED BELOW. THE NEW FUTURES PRICE LIMITS EFFECTIVE ON TRADE DATE JUNE 3, 2024 ARE SHOWN IN THE TABLE BELOW AND WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL THE FIRST TRADING DAY IN JUNE 2025.

CHINA SUSPENDS BEEF AND AT THE SAME TIME CHINA LIFTS SANCTIONS.

CHINA HAS HALTED BEEF EXPORTS FROM JBSUSA BECAUSE TRACES OF THE FEED ADDITIVE RACTOPA-MINE WAS FOUND FROM A JBS PLANT IN GREELEY, COLORADO. CHINA ALONG WITH 160 COUNTRIES DOESN'T ALLOW RACTOPAMINE. ALSO ON MAY 29TH CHINA SUSPENDED EXPORTS OF MEAT AND POULTRY FROM COOL PORT OAKLAND, A COLD STORAGE FACILITY IN OAKLAND, CALIFORNIA. THE RACTOPAMINE FOUND FROM BOTH FACILITIES WAS IN THE OMASUM. WITH 160 COUNTRIES THAT DON'T ALLOW RACTOPAMINE, DON'T BE SURPRISED IF OTHER COUNTRIES MIGHT SUSPEND BEEF EXPORTS.

AS BEEF EXPORTS FROM JBSUSA AND COOL PORT OAKLAND WERE SUSPENDED, CHINA ANNOUNCED THAT IT WAS LIFTING SUSPENSIONS FROM BEEF PACKERS IN AUSTRALIA FROM SANCTIONS FROM

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2020 WHEN CHINA SUSPENDED AUSTRALIAN BEEF BECAUSE OF LABELING, CONTAMINATION OR PEO-PLE CONTAMINATED WITH COVID. CHINA'S TRADE AT THE TIME WAS WORTH \$20.6 BILLION AUSTRALIAN DOLLARS.

2024 HAS NOT BEEN A GOOD YEAR FOR U.S. BEEF EXPORTS. 2024 FIRST QUARTER RESULTS FOR ALL US BEEF EXPORTS WAS DOWN 4 PERCENT FOLLOWING THE YEARLY EXPORTS FOR 2023 DOWN 12 PERCENT. FOR THE FIRST QUARTER CHINA TOOK 42,777 MT, DOWN 8 PERCENT FROM 2023. CHINA IS THE 4TH BUYER OF US BEEF

NATIONAL WEEKLY FED CATTLE COMPREHENSIVE REPORT MAY 29, 2024

AS OF MAY 29, 2024, DRESSED STEER AND HEIFER CARCASSES AVERAGED 888.6 POUNDS UP 1.2 POUNDS FROM PREVIOUS WEEK AND <u>UP 31.6 POUNDS FROM A YEAR AGO.</u> THE GRADING PERCENT AS OF 05/29/2024 WAS 83.5% COMPARED TO PREVIOUS WEEK AT 83.3%. ON MAY 30, 2023 CARCASSES WEIGHED 857.0 POUNDS AND GRADED 81.8%.

Sterling Marketing uses the Comprehensive Beef Cutout Value reported by USDA. I have included a document that explains this cutout value. I looked at this value about 4 years ago and compared the beef packer margin values from my Choice-Select Adjusted value and this Comprehensive value. There was little difference. However, over the past few weeks, the difference has become significant. I believe this is because the mix of cattle slaughtered is increasingly includes higher valued cattle – i.e., Prime, Upper 2/3 Choice, and Branded Program cattle. In addition, it includes the formula-priced cattle. Using just the Choice and higher grade and Select grade to generate the cutout does not reflect this important difference in the quality of cattle which in turn is definitely a driver to the notable improvement in beef demand over the past year.

FOR WEEK ENDING MAY 23, 2024 NET SALES WERE 15,700 MT DOWN 12 PERCENT ON THE 4 WEEK AVERAGE. JAPAN WAS THE LARGEST TAKER WITH 4,500 MT CHINA WAS SECOND WITH 2,800 MT AND MEXICO TOOK 1,500 MT. AS USUAL BEEF EXPORTS AREN'T HELPING TO MOVE BEEF.

PORK PRICES WERE HIGHER FOR THE WEEK. AS OF FRIDAY THE 5 DAY PORK CARCASS WAS UP \$1.83. LOINS GAINED \$1.06, AND HAMS WERE UP \$6.31. BUTTS WERE DOWN 70 CENTS, PICNICS UP 32 CENTS, RIBS WERE DOWN \$5.97 AND BELLIES WERE UP \$1.94. RIBS DOWN AFTER MEMORIAL DAY ISN'T UNUSUAL. LOINS UP AND ESPECIALLY HAMS WITH A BIG GAIN ARE THE POWER CUTS GAINING. IF HAMS CONTINUE TO GAIN, ITS LIKELY THIS TIME OF YEAR BECAUSE OF CONTINUED GOOD EXPORTS TO MEXICO.

THE CURRENT YEAR TO DATE HOG SLAUGHTER IS UP 372,086 HOGS. HIGHER PRICES FOR BEEF AND STRONG PORK EXPORTS CERTAINLY ARE HELPING HOG PRICES. COMPARED TO A YEAR AGO THE 5 DAY PORK CARCASS IS UP \$19.26. A YEAR AGO THE CME LEAN HOG INDEX WAS \$79.53 COMPARED TO THE CURRENT AT \$91.00. A YEAR AGO THE AVERAGE STEER PRICE WAS \$177.94 COMPARED TO CURRENT PRICES AT \$189.44 AND THE CME BEEF INDEX AT \$298.74 COMPARED TO THE CURRENT PRICE AT \$310.30

IT IS POSITIVE FOR PACKERS THAT PORK IS GAINING ON HOG PRICES. THE CME LEAN HOG INDEX IS \$10.17 UNDER THE CME PORK CUTOUT INDEX. IT DOESN'T MEAN PACKERS WILL PAY MORE FOR HOGS, BUT OVERALL IT GIVES STRENTH FOR THE TOTAL MARKET. IF PACKERS NEED HOGS TO PUSH MORE HOGS THROUGH THE KILL, THEY WON'T HESITATE BUYING HOGS.

EXPORTS

FOR THE WEEK ENDING MAY 23, 2024 NET EXPORTS WERE 44,400 MT UP 67 PERCENT ON THE 4 WEEK AVERAGE AND 67% ABOVE PREVIOUS WEEK. MEXICO CAME IN STRONG TAKING OVER HALF WITH 23,200 MT MAKING UP FOR LIGHT PURCHASE OVER THE PAST 3 WEEKS. AUSTRALIA TOOK 6,100 MT WITH JAPAN NEXT AT 3,600 MT. CHINA TOOK 2,400 MT.

AUSTRALIA BUYING AS MUCH MAY BE PART OF A TRADE DEAL BECAUSE THE U.S. HAS PICKED UP MORE BEEF FROM AUSTRALIA.
