JUNE LIVE CATTLE SETTLED AND WENT OFF THE BOARD FRIDAY AT \$193.50 EARLY ON FRIDAY, SHORTS BLEW OUT OF POSITIONS DRIVING LIVE CATTLE HIGHER THEN BY MID MORNING THE LONGS TOOK PROFITS AND PUSHED FUTURES LOWER ON THE DAY.

FOR THE WEEK THE BOXED BEEF MARKET WAS UP. THE CME BEEF INDEX GAINED \$1.09.

PACKERS WON'T NEED TO BE BIG BUYERS FOR THE SHORT KILL WEEK NEXT WEEK. TO MEET NEEDS PACKERS ARE PAYING HIGHER BUT ARE SELECTIVE ON QUALITY WHERE THEY PAY THE HIGHEST PRICES. BEEF PRICES ARE UP AND LOAD MOVEMENT THIS WEEK HAS BEEN LIGHT. IT APPEARS PACKERS WILL PAY HIGHER FOR CATTLE ON SELECTIVE BUYING AND HAVE SLAUGHTER AT LEVELS THAT FILL BEEF CON-TRACTS AND THEN LIMIT BEEF SOLD ON THE DAILY MARKET KEEPING BEEF PRICES UP.

PACKERS HAVE PAID UP TO \$200.00 ON LIMITED NUMBERS. THE MAJORITY OF MIDWEST CATTLE WAS \$198.00 AND IN THE SOUTHWEST WAS \$189.50. THE SPREAD BETWEEN REGIONS IS WIDENING.

AS OF JUNE 27, 2024 THE 5 DAY NEGOTIATED STEER PRICE WAS \$194.77 AND ON JUNE 28TH JUNE LIVE CATTLE SETTLED AT \$193.50

Sterling Marketing uses the Comprehensive Beef Cutout Value reported by USDA. I have included a document that explains this cutout value. I looked at this value about 4 years ago and compared the beef packer margin values from my Choice-Select Adjusted value and this Comprehensive value. There was little difference. However, over the past few weeks, the difference has become significant. I believe this is because the mix of cattle slaughtered is increasingly includes higher valued cattle – i.e., Prime, Upper 2/3 Choice, and Branded Program cattle. In addition, it includes the formula-priced cattle. Using just the Choice and higher grade and Select grade to generate the cutout does not reflect this important difference in the quality of cattle which in turn is definitely a driver to the notable improvement in beef demand over the past year.

USDA HOGS AND PIGS REPORT JUNE 27, 2024

UNITED STATES HOG INVENTORY UP 1 PERCENT

UNITED STATES INVENTORY OF ALL HOGS AND PIGS ON JUNE 1, 2024 WAS 74.5 MILLION HEAD. THIS WAS UP 1 PERCENT FROM JUNE 1, 2023, AND UP SLIGHTLY FROM MARCH 1, 2024.

BREEDING INVENTORY, AT 6.01 MILLION HEAD, WAS DOWN 3 PERCENT FROM LAST YEAR, AND DOWN SLIGHTLY FROM THE PREVIOUS QUARTER.

MARKET HOG INVENTORY, AT 68.5 MILLION HEAD, WAS UP 2 PERCENT FROM LAST YEAR, AND UP SLIGHTLY FROM LAST QUARTER.

THE MARCH-MAY 2024 PIG CROP, AT 34.0 MILLION HEAD, WAS UP 2 PERCENT FROM 2023. SOWS FARROWING DURING THIS PERIOD TOTALED 2.94 MILLION HEAD, UP SLIGHTLY FROM 2023. THE SOWS FARROWED DURING THIS QUARTER REPRESENTED 49 PERCENT OF THE BREEDING HERD. THE AVERAGE PIGS SAVED PER LITTER WAS 11.56 FOR THE MARCH-MAY PERIOD, COMPARED TO 11.36 LAST YEAR.

UNITED STATES HOG PRODUCERS INTEND TO HAVE 2.96 MILLION SOWS FARROW DURING THE JUNE-AUGUST 2024 QUARTER, DOWN 3 PERCENT FROM THE ACTUAL FARROWINGS DURING THE SAME

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PERIOD ONE YEAR EARLIER, AND DOWN 4 PERCENT FROM THE SAME PERIOD TWO YEARS EARLIER. INTENDED FARROWINGS FOR SEPTEMBER-NOVEMBER 2024, AT 2.94 MILLION SOWS, ARE DOWN 1 PERCENT FROM THE SAME PERIOD ONE YEAR EARLIER, AND DOWN 5 PERCENT FROM THE SAME PERIOD TWO YEARS EARLIER.

LEAN HOG PRICES CLOSED DOWN FOR THE WEEK FOLLOWING CASH HOGS AND PORK PRICES LOWER. SLAUGHTER WAS 2,000 MORE HEAD COMPARED TO A WEEK AGO, IT WAS UP APPROXIMATELY 88,500 HEAD FOR THE SAME PERIOD A YEAR AGO AND YEAR TO DATE SLAUGHTER IS UP 648,141 HEAD.

FOR THE WEEK THE CME LEAN HOG INDEX WAS DOWN 80 CENTS AND THE CME PORK CUTOUT WAS DOWN \$2.20.

FOR THE WEEK THE 5 DAY AVERAGE PRICES ON THE DAILY PORK SALES WAS DOWN \$2.10 WITH ALL PRIMAL CUTS LOWER EXCEPT FOR HAMS THAT GAINED 41.55. LOINS WERE DOWN \$3.02. BELLIES WERE OFF \$4.65. RETAILERS HAVE ENOUGH PORK AND PRE-JULY 4TH BUTTS, PICNICS AND RIBS WERE ALL LOWER.

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FOR THE PACKER, HOGS ARE FALLING AT A SLOWER PACE THAN PORK. THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE CME LEAN HOG INDEX AND THE CME PORK INDEX HAS NARROWED TO \$6.92 PUTTING THE PACKER WITH A NEGATIVE MARGIN.
