Beef prices started out the week up on Tuesday with good gains on Choice Rib primals and Choice and Select Loins. Volume was light with 115 total loads of beef moving.

On moderate trade volume Live Cattle futures made new contract highs Tuesday and new contract high closes. Spec traders were buying front months and selling succeeding months and remaining bear spread. A big part of the trade saw traders buying Hogs and selling Cattle on profit taking after last Friday's contract high.

June Live Cattle are trading discount to cash cattle. The 5 day average negotiated steer cash price at \$177.99 is premium to June 2023 Live Cattle settling Tuesday at \$168.87.

Feedlots will have the upper hand this week. Look for Midwest feedlots asking \$185.00 up to \$186.00 and Southwest feedlots wanting to close the gap but likely selling at \$175.00 to \$176.00. Packers need cattle but with poor profit margins, they can't give away the store and with weights dropping they are limited at what they can buy that fits orders for contracts.

BEEF NET EXPORTS FOR WEEK ENDING MAY 18, 2023 WERE 18,300 MT. There were no big buyers. Japan took 5,500 MT followed by South Korea at 3,800 MT and China at 2,500 MT. For the second week Canada was absent.

NATIONAL WEEKLY FED CATTLE COMPREHENSIVE REPORT MAY 23, 2023

As of May 23, 2023 dressed steer and heifer carcasses averaged 855.9 pounds down 1.8 pounds from previous week at 857.7 pounds and 4.2 pounds less than a year ago. The grading percent as of 5/23/23 was 82.2 % compared to previous week at 82.8%.

As of May 24, 2022 dressed steer and heifer carcasses averaged 860.1 pounds. The grading percent was 81.6%.



COMPARED TO LAST WEEK, STEERS AND HEIFERS SOLD STEADY TO 5.00 HIGHER. DEMAND WAS GOOD FOR CALVES WITH VERY GOOD DEMAND FOR YEARLING WEIGHT FEEDER CATTLE WHILE SUPPLY IS MODERATE FOR THIS TIME OF YEAR. THE FEEDER CATTLE

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MARKET CONTINUES TO MOVE HIGHER AS THE CASH FED CATTLE MARKET GREATLY OUTPACES THE CME CATTLE COMPLEX. THE GRAZING SEASON HAS BEGUN AND THE DEMAND FOR GRASS CATTLE IS RED HOT. MORE RAIN THIS WEEKEND IN PARCHED AREAS AS WELL AS PRECIPITATION IN THE FORECAST NEXT WEEK WILL HOPEFULLY HELP ALLEVIATE THE DROUGHT CONDITIONS.

The CME Lean Hog Index to the CME Pork Index is \$2.04 with hogs under the price of pork. When you add the costs of running a plant and processing company, the packer has negative profit margins.

Lean Hogs were higher Tuesday with profit taking and the trade evening up June Lean Hogs nearer to cash hogs and where the CME Lean Hog Index is priced. Last Friday Lean Hogs settled at \$76.07 and the CME Lean Hog Index at \$80.48.

However, a big part of the trade was profit taking on Live Cattle/Lean Hog spreads. Friday the June Live Cattle/June Lean Hog spread settled at \$91.12 that had a previously high spread on March 23, 2015 at \$79.37 and settled on June 12, 2015 at \$70.12. From May 2, 2023 to May 26, 2023 the spread gained \$18.32. From January 3, 2023 the spread gained \$42.60.

Pork exports are up in 2023 but they are up because pork exports in 2022 were low. The first quarter of 2023 all pork exports were up 14 percent but compared to the same period in 2022 pork exports were down 20 percent. With more hogs in 2023, pork exports need to surpass 2022 exports.
