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Boxed beef was lower for the third day on early sales Wednesday on good movement. It appears sellers are dumping beef on the daily market. Remember, daily sales are for 1 to 21 days and sellers also know if contracted orders and exports are being cancelled or not. Choice rib primals were of 10.64. Choice chucks down 3.53, Choice rounds down 2.64 and below Select rounds. Choice loins were up 5.55 and Choice briskets were up 2.96.

It is typical summer buying from consumers. Cooks are keeping ovens off and preparing recipes that are quick and easy to not heat up the house and to get outside when it is light outside later in the day.

High temperatures remain in Texas and parts of Oklahoma. Cattle weights in Texas have been running light and the extreme high temperatures are predicted throughout June.

Packers had a light buy of cash cattle Wednesday. In the Midwest cattle moved at 180.00 - 186.00 with an average price 184.34. In Kansas a mixed load sold for 178.00 - 186.00 with an average price 181.66. In the Texas, no prices were listed by the USDA.

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Trade volume on Live Cattle was light to moderate Wednesday and traders continue to bear spread anticipating more cattle placed on the upcoming COF report Friday.

BEEF NET EXPORTS FOR WEEK ENDING JUNE 8, 2023 WERE 12,800 MT, the same as the previous week China was the biggest buyer taking 4700 MT, followed by Japan with 3200 MT and Mexico taking 1800 MT.

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COMPARED TO LAST WEEK, STEERS AND HEIFERS SOLD MIXED; 3.00 LOWER TO 2.00 HIGHER. DEMAND WAS STILL REPORTED AS MODERATE TO GOOD. EARLY WEEK THERE WAS SOME UNEVENNESS AND SIDEWAYS MOVEMENT, BUT PRESSURE INCREASED AND AS THE WEEK PROGRESSED IT WAS UNDENIABLE THAT THE CALF MARKET WAS UNDOUBTEDLY LOWER. THE SUPPLY OF FEEDERS WAS MODERATE STILL MUCH ABOVE SEASONAL AVERAGES BUT NOT AS HEAVY AS LAST WEEK. MANY BUYERS REPORTED THAT ORDERS WERE STILL PRESENT BUT AT THE CURRENT PRICE LEVELS THERE IS JUST A LOT OF NERVOUSNESS TO PUSH PRICES ANY HIGHER.

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CORN AND WHEAT HIGHER WENESDAY ADDED TO THE NEGATIVITY TO FEEDER CATTLE FUTURES. GAPPING LOWER ON THE OPEN AND DROPPING BELOW THE 50 DAY MOVING AVERAGE FOR THE FIRST TIME SINCE NOVEMBER 11, 2022 FOR AUGUST FEEDERS AND THE VERY FIRST TIME FOR SEPTEMBER FEEDERS ON OUT.

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Summer hogs are bull spread to fall and 4<sup>th</sup> quarter hogs and traders are also bear spreading December Lean Hogs into 2024.

Pork prices were higher on early sales Wednesday. Cash hog prices continue higher, and weights almost daily are dropping. What has been happening since Lean Hogs bottomed on May 26<sup>th</sup> is also the opposite of what traders did since the start of the year Traders are buying hogs and reversing cattle and hog spreads.

Pork has been cheap and still remains cheap. High beef prices are helping pork move up. It was inevitable.

There are many consumers wanting to reduce food prices. Buying pork is one way to do it.

However, volume has been moderate as hogs have been moving up. Speculators are active.

January through April 2023, U.S. Pork Plus Pork Variety Meat Exports were up 14% compared to same time in 2022. Pork muscle cuts were up 9% and variety meat exports were up 37%.

Pork net export sales were 26,700 MT for week ending June 8, 2023. Mexico was largest buyer taking 10,700 MT followed by Japan taking 4,700 MT with Australia at 1900 MT, China also took 1900 MT and Canada with 1600 MT.
