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Futures trade volume was active Monday. Futures didn't make new highs and trading mostly were speculators profit taking on bear spreads and some hedging in 2024 near contract highs.

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For many low to middle income consumers beef prices are too high and concern about a recession in 2024 is a worry. Above are Boxed Beef primal prices comparing September 18, 2023 to September 18, 2022. It is easy to see why there is a concern. Also, compare beef prices to pork prices and cheap pork will gain on beef for the consumers wanting to save money on proteins.

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U.S. beef exports are dropping because they can't compete with beef prices from major competition like Brazil and Australia. All beef exports including variety meats as of the end of July were down 11%. Muscle Beef cuts were down 13% and Variety meat exports were down 5%.

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With a light kill last week packers had to raise prices to buy cattle Friday for this week's kill. The big change came from buyers in the Southwest raising prices up to \$183.00 and narrowing prices between the Midwest and Southwest. Cattle in the Midwest sold for 184.00 - 186.00 FOB with a hand full Live Delivered at 186.00 - 188.00 averaging 187.14.

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NATIONAL WEEKLY FED CATTLE COMPREHENSIVE REPORT AUGUST 22, 2023

As of August 22, 2023 dressed steer and heifer carcasses averaged 870.3 pounds up 5.3 pound\_from previous week at 865.0 pounds and 4.3 pounds lower at 874.6 pounds than a year ago. The grading percent as of 8/22/23 was down at 79.6% compared to previous week at 81.0%. A year ago the grading percent was 79.9%.

Compared to last week, Feeder Steers and Heifers sold steady to 4.00 Higher. Supply was moderate and demand was moderate to good. In Missouri reporters noted the temperature swings between night and day, making it more difficult to keep calves healthy, those coming to auction without legitimate health and weaning programs seeing discounts. Oklahoma reporters noted Rain and cooler temperatures moved across much of the state this week and this improved demand for calves. Across South Dakota Pastures are getting short and more cow/calf producers will be shipping their calves to town in the coming weeks.

Lean hog trade volume was light Monday. Spec traders, like Live Cattle, were unwinding bear spreads from December 2023 on out. October closed pennies higher up 12 cents as the morning pork market moved up but the daily pork carcass price up \$5.75 or the 5 day carcass average moving to \$100.17 did little to generate new bulls. As of Monday the CME Lean Hog Index was trading \$3.68 over October Lean Hogs.

Traders are looking at lean hogs from both sides. Pork is much cheaper than beef which is good news for pork, However, US hog slaughter is up with hogs starting to add weight and exports while still strong for 2023 have been slowing because of global competition.

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The CME Pork Index has widened out to \$12.39 over the CME Lean Hog Index.

Packers will try to push more hogs to slaughter especially as more pork isn't putting price pressure on the daily pork market. Fixed expenses per hog go down with more hogs killed.

Hog weights are starting to creep higher.
