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Cattle that couldn't make Tuesday's kill were able to be delivered Wednesday but with light beef sales, packers aren't going to push slaughter. Demand is over for holiday Choice primal rib buying. Moving forward the beef will need to see support from the middle and lower priced sections. In 2024 traders will be watching for any consistent moves down on financial markets or upturns on energy markets.

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Feedlots are asking more this week. With a weaken beef market, if packers end up paying more, it is because feedlots are holding off sales until the January even though they can get deferred checks. Feedlots are simply adding pounds which could backfire if beef prices drop.

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Cash cattle prices last week were up a solid \$2.00 and for some cattle \$3.00 higher, but buying was light especially in the Southwest. This week is a short kill week and next week will be another shortened week. Last week kill was just 621,000 head.

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The 5 day negotiated average steer price as of December 26th was \$170.00. Wednesday, December 27, 2023 December 2023 Live Cattle settled at \$170.72.

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#### **EXPORTS**

Exports should increase in 2024. When beef exports for 2023 are down 15% there should see some improvement, but don't look for a big increase with competition having trade agreements that will be hard for the US to break so exporters buy US beef.

For week ending December 14, 2023 net sales were 9700 MT. South Korea took 4200 MT and Japan 2600MT with Mexico buying 1100 MT. China took only 400 MT and Canada 600 MT. Beef exports have lost buyers due to Brazil selling to past big buyers of US beef.

As of December 27, 2023, dressed steer and heifer carcasses averaged 903.5 pounds down 4.5 pounds from previous week but up 11.2 pounds from a year ago. The grading percent as of 12/27/23 was 82.5% compared to previous week at 83.0% down .5%. On December 28, 2022 carcasses weighed 894.2 pounds and graded 83.0%.

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Light volume trade on Wednesday. Spec traders were bear spreading. Packers were able to bring in hogs that missed Tuesday's kill due to snow but with light pork sales, they aren't pushing kill. Look for light trading the remainder of the week.

Pork movement was also light. Hams on the daily buy were up on early sales \$5.70 and end the day up 3.52 but it didn't help the 5 day average currently at 74.98 Hams are cheap and although there wasn't a surge on demand during the holidays, processors and retailers may need to refill inventories.

#### **EXPORTS**

FOR WEEK ENDING DECEMBER 14, 2023 NET EXPORTS WERE 37,500 MT. MEXICO TOOK 15,900 MT, SOUTH KOREA 7000 MT AND CANADA WITH 3200 MT. JAPAN BOUGHT 3000 MT AND CHINA WITH 2800 MT EXPORTS WERE VERY GOOD. BUT BIG EXPORTS DEPEND ON MEXICO. MEXICAN PESO IS STRONG AND MEXICO IS BUYING MORE PORK FROM THE US AND BRAZIL IN 2023 TO FIGHT INFLATION.
