Last week cash cattle price were \$1.00 to \$2.00 Lower. Midwest cattle sold for \$173.00 to \$175.00 with dressed prices \$273.00. Southwest cattle didn't sell until Friday with prices \$172.00.

Cattle haven't disappeared they are in feedlots and as soon as weather allows movement, packers are going to have to push lines to make up for cattle and beef that has been scheduled.

Packers are working with negative margins. They aren't going to kill more than they need to kill. They will first kill their cattle from their own feedlots and from contract feedlots and buy showlist cattle to fill in any gaps. Next week because of the increase in beef prices, packer margins should show improvement, but when slaughter is cut as much as it has been of late, packers have a higher cost to kill per animal.

Live Cattle traders are not looking at the storm, recent cattle prices or the current price of beef on the daily market. They are anticipating what will likely happen from February on out.

First notice day for February 2024 Live Cattle is February 5, 2024.

As of January 9, 2024, dressed steer and heifer carcasses averaged 899.2 pounds down 4.1 pounds from previous week but <u>up 16.5 pounds from a year ago</u>. The grading percent as of 01/09/24 was 83.4 % compared to previous week at 83.6 % down .2%. On January 10, 2023 carcasses weighed 882.7 pounds and graded 84.1 % .

Pork prices have improved due to the light slaughter because of the snow and sub-zero temperatures. Packing plants have fewer people showing up either because they can't travel on roads or need to stay home with children home from school. But as weather moderates, roads are cleared and schools reopen, look for packers to increase line speed and put more pork into the market. Packers have positive profit margins. They want to kill hogs and need to kill to make up for light movement on contracted pork.

#### **EXPORTS**

FOR THE START OF THE NEW YEAR EXPORTS AT 23,300 MT WERE GOOD. THIS IS THE AVERAGE EXPORTS NEED TO BE WEEK AFTER WEEK TO BE SAID THEY ARE PRICE SUPPORTING. IT IS A BIT DISAPPOINTING TO HAVE MEXICO BUY ONLY 7,400 MT AND EXPORTS FOR 2024 NEED TO HAVE SOUTH KOREA AND JAPAN MORE THAN THEY DID LAST WEEK.

FOR WEEK ENDING JANUARY 4, 2024 NET EXPORTS WERE 23,300 MT. MEXICO WAS THE LARGEST BUYER WITH 7400 MT FOLLOWED BY JAPAN WITH 4300 MT AND SOUTH KOREA TOOK 4100 MT CHINA BOUGHT NOTHING. NET SALES REUCTIONS OF 73,500 MT WERE CARRIED OVER FROM 2023. EXPORTS OF THE PERIOD ENDING DECEMBER 31ST OF 10,500 MT BROUGHT ACCUMULATED EXPORTS TO 1,580,000 MT, UP 5 PERCENT FROM THE PRIOR YEAR TOTAL OF 1,502,900 MT.
