April Live Cattle settled higher Monday at \$180.30 as futures moved nearer to cash. Last week cash cattle in the Southwest averaged \$181.85 and in the Midwest cattle averaged \$184.00. The 5 day accumulated weighted steer price as of April 15th was \$184.00. For the month there haven't been any deliveries.

Friday, the April/June Live Cattle spread closed with June under April by \$7.42. Monday the spread narrowed with June \$6.47 under April.

Boxed beef prices started out 54 cents higher Monday on morning sales, but total load movement was just 35 loads with 20 loads of Choice

By the afternoon, Choice boxed beef was 31 cents higher than Friday, Select boxed beef was down \$4.20 with Select Chucks dropping \$12.80. Total movement of all beef was 90 loads.

Last Friday packers finished buying with bids down \$1.00 to steady with Thursday. Midwest cattle sold for \$185.00 with dressed prices \$293.00 to \$295.00 . Southwest cattle were \$182.00. Compared to last week cattle were a solid \$2.00 lower.

Slaughter for week ending April 13th dropped by 10,000 from previous week and year to date slaughter is down 481,498 head.

Moderate to good demand for all weights of steers and heifers, but with the continued down pressure from the futures contracts, cattle feeders have been put on the defensive. The market is still active for those thin fleshed cattle but there is much more apprehension in the minds of cattle producers as the futures contracts fail to follow the cash market.

Cash hogs and pork have been trending higher and packer margins are positive. The CME Lean Hog Index to the CME Pork Index is positive for packers.

June 2024 Lean Hogs is now the front month. There are 2 months before it expires. Although there is a May Lean Hog contract, it is rarely used and by now speculative traders would have rolled to June.

The spread between April and June closed at \$11.20 on Friday with June over April.

Exports have been strong and have helped to offset the increase of hogs in 2024.

Going forward, traders will be monitoring exports especially looking for any decreases.
