With higher boxed beef prices feedlots will be asking at least \$2.00 higher. But there is the possibility beef prices drop Wednesday and Thursday. The higher beef prices are likely due to demand for late buyers for Mother Day and increasing beef needs for Memorial Day. Daily beef sales are light suggesting sellers are first filling previously contracted beef orders.

Live Cattle traders are cautious not knowing when news of Avian Flu may drive futures lower. With June and August bull spread, the large traders remain bullish. With the swings in the market, at this time it is best to be spread than outright long futures even with the discount futures have to cash. With more than a month until first notice day for June, there is plenty of time for futures and cash to move to closer to convergence.

Last week cash cattle in the Midwest on light sales were \$1.00 higher from \$186.00 to \$187.00 and dressed prices \$295.00. Cash cattle in the Southwest were \$1.00 to \$2.00 higher mostly \$184.00 on light sales. As of Friday total head sold negotiated in Texas. Oklahoma and New Mexico were just 2,557 head.

Tuesday traders were rolling out of June and into July on out. Currently, cash hogs have been slowly moving down. The CME Lean Hog Index is at \$90.80. Yesterday formula and carcass priced hogs ranged from \$88.71 to \$90.03.

'Rio Grande do Sul state accounts for 11% of Brazil's total chicken production and for 19.8% of pork supplies, ABPA data showed. Part of the volume is sold on export markets.'

For the Daily Pork Report Monday and Tuesday is a good example why watching daily movement is not a good way to monitor pork price movement. Sales on daily loads are a small part of pork prices and the daily price fluctuations are not a good representation for price movement. The five day average at least smooths out the ups and downs from one day to the next.

Cash hogs are slowly going down. Weighted average prices on formula and carcass priced hogs making up the majority of hogs sold are averaging near 90.00.

Stronger exports last week weren't much help for futures trading. But with June and summer hogs premium to cash, it is hard to get them energized to move higher.
